

Where in the literature does **any** linkage between predestination and spiritual intimacy appear?

I have checked the ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials for journal articles. Here is what I found:

"immanence" yielded 895 results

"predestination" yielded 990 results

Then searching "immanence" AND "predestination" yielded 0 results!
